Votes on Ross & Frankel Budget Motions 5-11-04

On 5-11-04 in the Pa. State House, anti-family leaders made two efforts to secure more public funds for Planned Parenthood, et al. This was done during budget hearings. The first move was led by Rep. Ross. His motion would have provided \$6 million for breast cancer screening, **but** the funds would go **only** to Title X agencies, i.e. PP, et al. This was rejected by a 143 to 57 vote. Then, Rep. Frankel offered a motion to provide \$9.7 million for the screening and treatment of "low income adult women and their partners." Again, the funds would go **only** to Title X providers. To qualify as a Title X provider, you must counsel, refer for, or perform abortions. Legitimate health care providers do not qualify and would receive none of these funds. The Frankel Amendment was defeated 138-61. Fortunately, these two blatant efforts to secure funds for abortion providers were exposed by Reps Mary Ann Dailey, Thomas Tigue and Jerry Birmelin.

You will note that as in earlier efforts, a legitimate need is specified - a) breast cancer screening b) poverty - and then used as a smoke screen to provide more public monies for those who teach our young to be promiscuous and then abort their offspring. Many of the negative votes came from our area. Please write and visit your House Reps, regardless of how they voted. Applaud those who voted correctly, convert those who did not. Do they know what Planned Parenthood has done to our youth, to our Nation?

A "yes" vote is a vote to fund Title X agencies - Planned Parenthood, et al. A "no" vote is a pro-family/pro-life vote. "A" is absent.
